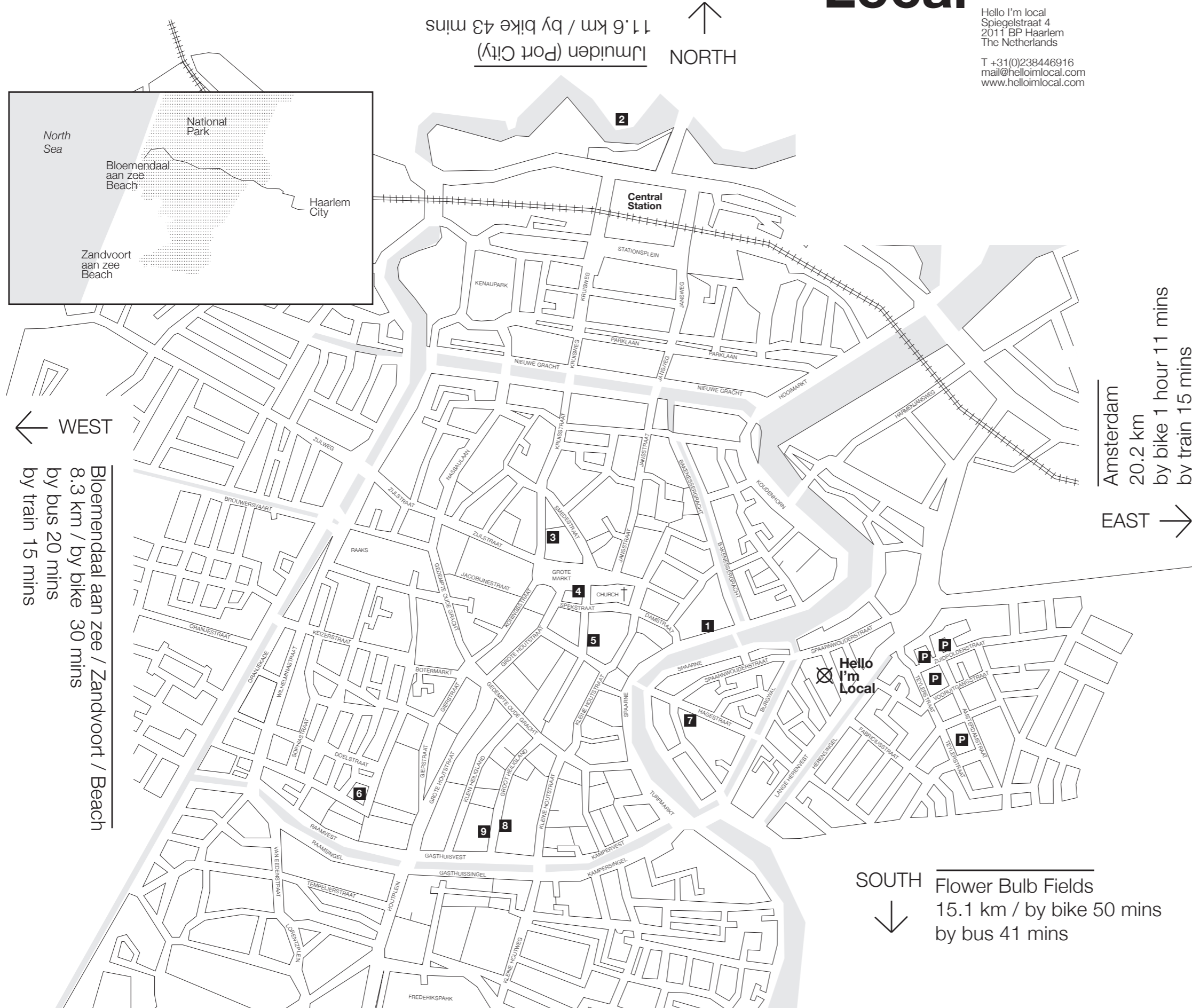

## 1 Teylers Museum

Teylers Museum, is the Netherlands' first and oldest museum, open to the public since 1784. **Spaarne 16**

## 2 Museum het Dolhuys

Experience the world of madness in the Dolhuys. Meet madmen and lunatics, or clients as they are known today, in the interactive museum and find out how the Netherlands has dealt with madness throughout the centuries. **Schotersingel 2**

## 3 Corrie ten Boomhuis

The home of Corrie ten Boom is now a museum! Much of the house has been refurbished to appear as it did in the 1940's. Visitors can see the actual "hiding place," which is a small area behind a false wall in Corrie's bedroom. This is where Jews and others were safely hidden from the Nazis. **Barteljorisstraat 19**

## 4 De Hallen

De Hallen Haarlem is the museum for modern and contemporary art. **Grote Markt 16**

## 5 Hofje In Den Groenen Tuin

It was founded in 1616 by Catherina Jansdr. Amen, the widow of Jacob Claesz. van Schoor. **Warmoesstraat 23**

## 6 De Nieuwe Kerk

The church dates from the 17th century. The tower was built by Lieven de Key against the older St. Anna church that itself was replaced by a design by Jacob van Campen in 1645-1649. **Nieuwe Kerkplein**

## 7 Rosenstock-Huessy Huis

This house used to be called Sint Jacobs Godshuis and opened its doors in 1436 to house pilgrims on their way to Santiago de Compostella. Even today this is the place to get your stamp. **Hagestraat 10**

## 8 Frans Hals Museum

The museum's collection of Haarlem Old Masters of the Golden Age, including the world's largest collection of paintings by Frans Hals, is unique. **Groot Heiligland 62**

## 9 Historisch Museum Haarlem

Historisch Museum Haarlem is a city museum located on the other side of the street from the Frans Hals Museum. It shares its front door with the ABC Architectuurcentrum Haarlem, which is located next door. The museum is devoted to presenting and preserving the cultural history of Haarlem and the surrounding region. **Groot Heiligland 47**
